"...you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8 (NIV)

I will be a great witness for Jesus...

1. When I devote myself to *learning what Jesus teaches*. (v.42a)

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching...

Accept my teachings and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit, and you will find rest for your lives.

Matthew 11:29 (NCV)

Life is spiritual. Your physical existence doesn't contribute to that life. The words that I have spoken to you are spiritual. They are life. John 6:63 (GWT)

But dedicate your lives to Christ as Lord. Always be ready to defend your confidence in God when anyone asks you to explain it. 1 Peter 3:15 (GWT)

2. When I devote myself to God's family. (v.42a)

They devoted themselves to... fellowship...

... they were like family to each other.

Acts 2:42a (CEV)

All the believers kept meeting together, and they shared everything with each other. ⁴⁵ From time to time, they sold their property and other possessions and distributed the money to anyone who needed it. ⁴⁶ The believers had a single purpose and went to the temple every day. They were joyful and humble as they ate at each other's homes and shared their food. Acts 2:44-46 (NIV) A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵ By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. John 13:34-35 (NIV)

3. When I devote myself to accepting God's love. (v.42)

All the believers devoted themselves to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper)... Acts 2:42 (NLT)

This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners"—and I am the worst of them all. ¹⁶ But God had mercy on me so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life. **1Timothy 1:15-16 (NLT)**

We carry the death of Jesus in our own bodies so that the life of Jesus can also be seen in our bodies. **2 Corinthians 4:10 (NCV)**

4. When I devote myself to <u>depend on God's power</u>. (v.42)

They devoted themselves to...prayer.

... pray continually... 1 Thessalonians 5:17 (NIV)

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NLT)
