⁹ I've commanded you to be strong and brave. <u>Don't ever be afraid</u> or discouraged! **Joshua 1:9a (CEV)**

Three ways I can respond to my fear:

- I can choose to live with my fear.
- I can run from my fear.
- I can face my fear.

Four beliefs that help me overcome my fears:

- 1. Following Jesus will not make me immune to storms. (v.23-24)
- And when he got into the boat, his disciples followed him.
 A windstorm arose on the sea, so great that the boat was being swamped by the waves; ...
 Matthew 8:23-24a (NRSV)
- ³³ I told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have trouble, but be brave! I have defeated the world.

 John 16:33 (NCV)
- 2. <u>It's more about the storm in me than the storm I'm in</u>. (v.26)
- ³⁷ But soon a terrible storm arose. High waves began to break into the boat until it was nearly full of water and about to sink. ³⁸ Jesus was asleep at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. Frantically they wakened him, shouting, "Teacher, <u>don't you even care</u> that we are all about to drown?" Mark 4:37-38 (TLB)

²⁶ And he said to them, "Why are you afraid, you of little faith?" Matthew 8:26a (NRS)
²⁷ I'm leaving you with a gift, <u>peace of mind and heart</u> . And the peace that I give <u>isn't fragile like the peace the world gives</u> . So don't be troubled, don't be afraid. John 14:27 (TLE
3. No matter what happens, God will be with me. (v.23-24, 25)
²³ And when he got into the boat, his disciples followed him. ²⁴ A windstorm arose on the sea, so great that the boat was being swamped by the waves; <u>but he was asleep</u> . Matthew 8:23-24 (NRS)
²⁵ And they went and woke him up, saying, "Lord, save us!" Matthew 8:25a (NRS)
 <u>Prayer</u> wakes Jesus up more than the thunder and the wind
26 Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a dead calm. Matthew 8:26b (NRSV
²⁷ "It's all right. <u>I am here!</u> Don't be afraid." Matthew 14:27 (NL)
4. I get my focus back on Jesus. (v.27)
²⁷ <u>They were amazed</u> , saying, " <u>What sort of man is this</u> , that even the winds and the sea obey him?" Matthew 8:27 (NRS)
² We must <u>focus on Jesus</u> , the source and goal of our faith ³ <u>Thir</u> <u>about Jesus</u> , who endured opposition from sinners, so that you don't become tired and give up. Hebrews 12:2-3 (GW)
