¹⁶ Work happily together...

Romans 12:16a (TLB)

What happens when we work well together?

1. By working together, we **build up God's body**.

¹⁶ The whole body depends on Christ, and all the parts of the body are joined and held together. Each part does its own work to make the whole body grow and be strong with love.

Ephesians 4:16 (NCV)

2. By working together, we **complete God's mission**.

¹⁰ Aristarchus, who is in prison with me, sends you his greetings, and so does Mark, Barnabas's cousin. As you were instructed before, make Mark welcome if he comes your way. ¹¹ Jesus (the one we call Justus) also sends his greetings. These are the only Jewish believers among my co-workers; they are working with me here for the Kingdom of God. And what a comfort they have been!

The 5 marks of working well with others:

1. | recognize my limitations.

⁹ Two people are better than one. When <u>two people work</u> <u>together</u>, they get more work done... ¹¹ a person sleeping alone will not be warm. **Ecclesiastes 4:9, 11b (ERV)**

2. I share the same goal with my co-workers.

10 Be completely joined together again with the <u>same kind of</u>
 <u>thinking</u> and the <u>same purpose</u>.
 1 Corinthians 1:10b (ERV)

...² fulfill my <u>iov</u> by thinking the same way, having the same love, sharing the same feelings, <u>focusing on one goal</u>.

Philippians 2:2 (HSCH)

²⁷ Be sure that you live in a way that brings honor to the Good News of Christ. Then whether I come and visit you or am away from you, I will hear that you are standing strong with one purpose that you work together as one for the faith of the Good News.

Philippians 1:27 (NCV)

3. I treat others the same way God treats me.

13 Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.

⁹ Love prospers when a fault is forgiven, but <u>dwelling on it</u> separates close friends. **Proverbs 17:9 (NLT)**

4. I resolve conflicts with my co-workers God's way.

10 ... You must get along with each other. You must learn to be considerate of one another, cultivating a life in common.
