2. I ask God to help me understand.

¹²⁵ I am your servant; give me understanding, so that I may know your teachings. Psalm 119:125 (GNT)

³ Ask for good judgment. Cry out for understanding. ⁴ Look for wisdom like silver. Search for it like hidden treasure. ⁵ If you do this, you will understand what it means to respect the LORD, and you will come to know God. ⁶ The LORD is the source of wisdom; knowledge and understanding come from his mouth. **Proverbs 2:3-6 (ERV)**

3. I meditate on the thoughts of God.
