Two things have a huge impact on my time:

My <u>circumstances</u> and my <u>attitude</u>.

So be careful how you live. Live as men who are wise and not foolish. ¹⁶ Make the best use of your time. These are sinful days. **Ephesians 5:15-16 (NLV)**

Teach us to use wisely all the time we have. Psalm 90:12 (CEV)

What can I do to make the best use of the time I have?

1. I approach each day as a gift from God.

My times are in your hands... Psalm 31:15a (NIV)

This is the day that the Lord has made. Let us be full of joy and be glad in it.

Psalm 118:24 (NLV)

2. I commit my time to God.

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering.

Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him.
