Do not worship any god <u>except</u> me.

Exodus 20:3 (CEV)

Don't bow down and worship idols. I am the Lord your God, and <u>I</u> <u>demand all your love</u>. If you reject me, I will punish your families for three or four generations. **Exodus 20:5 (CEV)**

Therefore, my dearly beloved, shun (keep clear away from, avoid by
flight if need be) any sort of idolatry (of loving or venerating anything
more than God).1 Corinthians 10:14 (AMPC)

My little children, guard yourselves from idols. 1 John 5:21 (ASV)

I guard myself against idolatry...

1. When I search my heart for personal idols.

Son of man, these men have set up idols in their hearts...

Ezekiel 14:3a (CSB)

Let's take a good look at the way we're living and reorder our lives under God. Lamentations 3:40 (MSG)

2. When I'm convinced that my idols have to go.

This is what you must do to those people: <u>Tear down</u> their altars, <u>smash</u> their holy stone pillars, <u>cut down</u> their Asherah idols, and <u>burn</u> <u>their idols</u> in the fire. ⁶ You are holy people who belong to the LORD your God. He has chosen you from all the people on earth to be his very own. **Deuteronomy 7:5-6 (NCV)**

So <u>put to death</u> the sinful, earthly things <u>lurking within you</u>. Have nothing to do with sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. Don't be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world. **Colossians 3:5 (NLT)**

So let us run the race that is before us and never give up. <u>We</u> <u>should remove from our lives anything that would get in the way</u>. And we should remove the sin that so easily catches us. **Hebrews 12:1 (ICB)**

3. When I dedicate all I have to God's glory.

They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and <u>worshiped and</u> <u>served created things</u> rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen. Romans 1:25 (NIV)

For everything comes from God alone. Everything lives by his power, and <u>everything is for his glory</u>. To him be glory evermore. Romans 11:36 (TLB)

So whether you eat or drink, or <u>whatever you do</u>, <u>do it all for the</u> <u>glory of God</u>. **1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV)**

4. When I make it clear who is Lord of my life.

So who even comes close to being like God? To whom or what can you compare him? Some no-god idol? Ridiculous!

Isaiah 40:18 (MSG)

Idols are of no use, so don't worship them. They can't help you or save you. They are useless!

1 Samuel 12:21 (NCV)

But in your hearts set Christ apart [as holy—acknowledging Him, giving Him first place in your lives] <u>as Lord</u>.

1 Peter 3:15a (AMP)

You are to regard only the Lord of Hosts as holy. Only He should be feared; only He should be held in awe. Isaiah 8:13 (HCSB)
