We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, 10 so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him Colossians 1:9b-10a (NIV) in every way:

Worthy (axios) - deserving, in keeping with, corresponding to; comparable, countervailing - Romans 8:18; 2 Corinthians 4:17-18. Suitable, due - Luke 23:41.

# How do I "live a life worthy of the Lord"?

#### 1. I choose real hope.

But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation— 23 if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. Colossians 1:22-23a (NIV)

## 2. I have multiple mission statements.

I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, 11 and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead. Philippians 3:10-11 (NIV)

### 3. I (learn to) Live by the Spirit.

So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. Galatians 5:16 (NIV)

Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Galatians 6:8 (NIV)

#### 4. I examine myself regularly.

Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you unless, of course, you fail the test? 6 And I trust that you will discover that we have not failed the test.
