Think about the things that are true and honorable and right...
Philippians 4:8b (NCV)

The wicked bluff their way through, but the virtuous think before they act.

Four power thoughts that will help me determine what is right.

1. I think about what God wants.

I spend time thinking about your rules. I consider how you want me to live.
Psalms 119:15 (NIRV)

Think through what's going to be pleasing to the Lord.
Ephesians 5:10a (NTE)

Our only goal is to always please the Lord, whether we are living here in this body or there with him.
2 Corinthians 5:9 (ERV)

2. I think about Jesus.

So all of you holy brothers and sisters, who were called by God, think about Jesus, who was sent to us and is the high priest of our faith.
Hebrews 3:1 (NCV)

Think about Jesus. He patiently endured the angry insults that sinful people were shouting at him. Think about him so that you won't get discouraged and stop trying.
Hebrews 12:3 (ERV)

...Think the same way that Christ Jesus thought.
Philippians 2:5 (CEV)

This is what you were called to do, because Christ suffered for you and gave you an example to follow. So you should do as he did.

3. I think about people.

Each one of you should not think only about himself, but about other people also.
Philippians 2:4 (WE)

...Focus your thoughts on what is right in the sight of all people.
Romans 12:17 (ISV)

Hebrews 10:24 (NLT)

- Think of unbelievers...

People who don't believe are living all around you. They may say that you are doing wrong. So live such good lives that they will see the good you do, and they will give glory to God on the day he comes.

4. I think about eternity.

I am here on earth for just a little while...
