And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.

Walk with me and work with me... Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly. Matthew 11:28-29 (MSG)

Three commitments that will reset my walk with God:

I make a commitment to be <u>close</u> to God.

Come close to God, and he will come close to you. James 4:8a (GWT)

When my thoughts were bitter and my feelings were hurt, ²² I was as stupid as an animal; I did not understand you. ²³ <u>Yet I always stay close to you, and you hold me by the hand.</u> ²⁴ <u>You guide me</u> with your instruction and at the end you will receive me with honor... ²⁷Those who abandon you will certainly perish... ²⁸ <u>But as for me, how wonderful to be near God</u>... **Psalm 73:21-24, 27-28 (GNT)**

Those who listen to me are happy. <u>They stand watching at my door every day</u>. They are at my open doorway, <u>wanting to be with me</u>.

Proverbs 8:34 (ICB)

2. I make a commitment to **commune** with God.

I deeply love your Law! I think about it all day. Psalm 119:97 (CEV)

Lord, every morning you hear my voice. Every morning, I tell you what I need, and I wait for your answer. Psalm 5:3 (NCV)

LORD God, you are my Savior. I have been praying to you day and night.

Psalm 88:1 (ERV)

Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long. Psalm 25:5 (NIV)

I am always praising you. All day long I honor you. Psalm 71:8 (NCV)

3. I make a commitment to *comply* with God.

<u>Blessed</u> are all who fear the Lord, who <u>walk in obedience</u> to him.

Psalm 128:1 (NIV)

Do two people walk <u>hand in hand</u> if they aren't going to the same place?

Amos 3:3 (MSG)

You're blessed when you stay on course, walking steadily on the road revealed by God. You're blessed when you follow his directions, doing your best to find him. That's right—you don't go off on your own; you walk straight along the road he set. You, God, prescribed the right way to live; now you expect us to live it. Oh, that my steps might be steady, keeping to the course you set... I learn the pattern of your righteous ways. I'm going to do what you tell me to do...

Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
