In your lives you must **think** and act like Christ Jesus.

Beware that no one distracts you or intimidates you in their attempt to lead you away from Christ's fullness by pretending to be full of wisdom when they're filled with endless arguments of human logic. 1. I understand who I am and why I am here.

John 10:10 (TLB)

This is how we know what love is: <u>Christ gave</u> his life for us. We too, then, ought <u>to give</u> our lives for others! **1 John 3:16 (GNT)**

2. I understand God is always with me.

I am not alone because the Father is always with me.

John 16:32 (NLT)

3. I understand what to say.

I have not spoken on my own. Instead, the Father who sent me tells me what I should say and how I should say it.

John 12:49 (GW)

4. I understand who to please.

I only try to <u>please the One who sent me</u>.

John 5:30 (NCV)

A voice came from heaven and said, "You are my Son, the one I love. I am very pleased with you."

Mark 1:11 (ERV)

5. I understand how to treat those who harm me.

Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.

Luke 23:34 (NIV)

You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' ⁴⁴ But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you.

Matthew 5:43-44 (MEV)

6. I understand *I am alive to do God's will, not mine*.

For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me.

John 6:38 (NIV)

Father, if you are willing, please take away this cup of horror from me. But I want your will, not mine.

Luke 22:42b (TLB)

7. I understand what lies ahead.

He (Jesus) was willing to die a shameful death on the cross because of the joy he knew would be his afterwards; and now he sits in the place of honor by the throne of God.
