- My **Emotions**.
- My Circumstances.
- My **Goals**.
- My *Faith*.

## Three questions that will clarify my priorities:

### Question #1- Does God really exist?

The wicked arrogantly thinks: "There is no accountability, since God does not exist."

Psalm 10:4 (HCSB)

The fool says in his heart, "God does not exist." They are <u>corrupt</u>; they do <u>vile deeds</u>. **Psalm 14:1 (HCSB)** 

Without faith no one can please God. Whoever comes to God must believe that <u>he is real</u> and that <u>he rewards</u> those who sincerely try to find him.

Hebrews 11:6 (ERV)
