Jesus treated us much better than we deserve. He made us acceptable to God and gave us the hope of eternal life.

Because I am in Christ, I am <u>extremely valuable</u>. (v.9)

You are a holy nation, people who belong to God...

1 Peter 2:9 (ERV)

Holy is more about <u>selection</u> than <u>perfection</u>.

You are precious to me... That's why I am willing to trade others, to give up whole nations, to save your life. Isaiah 43:4 (ERV)

You have been bought and paid for by Christ, so you belong to him... 1 Corinthians 7:23 (TLB)
