What makes a great sermon?

1. A good speaker...

...instruction is appreciated if it is well presented.

Proverbs 16:21 (NLT)

When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, 29 because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.

Matthew 5:28-29 (NIV)

• The Sermon on the Mount is the sermon of a KING!

2. A good message...

The words I told you are spirit, and they give life.

John 6:63b (NCV)

3. A good response...

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

Matthew 7:24 (NIV)

I make the Sermon on the Mount the best sermon ever...

1. When I open my heart to God's message.

Pilate asked him, "So you are a king?" Jesus replied, "You're correct in saying that I'm a king. I have been born and have come into the world for this reason: to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to **me**." John 18:37 (GWT)

Are you listening to **me**? Really listening? Matthew 11:15 (MSG)

2. When I ask God to help me understand His message.

3. When I apply God's message.

So they come as though they are sincere and sit before you listening. But they have no intention of doing what I tell them to; they talk very sweetly about loving the Lord, but with their hearts they are loving their money. 32 You are very entertaining to them, like someone who sings lovely songs with a beautiful voice or plays well on an instrument. They hear what you say but don't pay any attention to it!
