How does gentleness bless my life?

1. Gentleness <u>defuses conflict</u>.

A gentle answer quiets anger, but a harsh one stirs it up.

Proverbs 15:1 (GNT)

Don't leave your job just because your boss [ruler; leader] is angry with you. Remaining calm [Gentleness] solves [appeases] great problems [offenses].

Ecclesiastes 10:4 (EXB)

2. Gentleness disarms critics.

We appeal gently when evil things are said about us.

1 Corinthians 4:13 (NLT)

Use clean language that no one can criticize. Do this, and your enemies will be too ashamed to say anything against you.

Titus 2:8 (CEV)

3. Gentleness is persuasive.

A wise, mature person is known for his understanding. The more pleasant his words, the more persuasive he is.

With patience, you can make anyone change their thinking, even a ruler. Gentle speech is very powerful. **Proverbs 25:15 (ERV)**

God's people must not be quarrelsome; they must be gentle, patient teachers of those who are wrong. ²⁵ Be humble when you are trying to teach those who are mixed up concerning the truth. 4. Gentleness is attractive.

...as a person dedicated to God... pursue righteousness, godliness, faithfulness, love, endurance, and gentleness.

1 Timothy 6:11 (NET)
