I pray for you constantly, ¹⁷ asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. ¹⁸ I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance. ¹⁹ I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him.

1. The Bright and Morning Star promises to guide me.

But when you consider the wonderful truth of the prophets' words, then the light will dawn in your souls and Christ the Morning Star will shine in your hearts.

2 Peter 1:18-19 (TLB)

Look to God's instructions and teachings! People who contradict his word are completely in the dark. Isaiah 8:20 (NLT)

Who among you fears the Lord and obeys his servant? That person may walk in the dark and have no light. Then let him trust in the Lord. Let him depend on his God. ¹¹ But instead, some of you want to light your own fires. You want to make your own light. So, go, walk in the light of your fires. Trust your own light to guide you. But this is what you will receive from me: You will lie down in a place of pain.

Isaiah 50:10-11 (ICB)

2. The Bright and Morning Star promises an end to my darkness.

I have come into the world as light, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in the darkness. **John 12:46 (GNT)**

The LORD's unfailing love and mercy still continue, ²³ Fresh as the morning, as sure as the sunrise. Lamentations 3:22-23 (GNT)

In the past you were full of darkness, but now you are full of light in the Lord. So live like children who belong to the light. ⁹ This light produces every kind of goodness, right living, and truth. ¹⁰ Try to learn what pleases the Lord. Ephesians 5:8-10 (ERV)
