Who Do You Say I Am? #11 John 1:1-18 Tim Gill - March 22, 2015

What is the message of The Word?

1. The WORD reveals God's *character*. (v.1-3,18)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.² He was with God in the beginning.³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. John 1:1-3 (NIV)

No one has ever seen God. But God the only Son is very close to the Father, and he has shown us what God is like. John 1:18 (NCV)

What does John say about Jesus?

• Jesus is <u>God</u>! "...The Word was God ..."

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. Colossians 1:15a (NIV)

• Jesus is <u>eternal</u>... "...in the beginning was The Word..."

I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. Revelation 22:13 (NIV)

• Jesus is my creator... "Through him all things were made..."

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation,¹⁶ for through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see—such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him.¹⁷ He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together. ¹⁸ Christ is also the head of the church, which is his body. He is the beginning, supreme over all who rise from the dead. So he is first in everything.

Colossians 1:15-18 (NLT)

2. The WORD explains God's *plan*. (v.3-5)

And with this Word, God created all things. Nothing was made without the Word. Everything that was created ⁴ received its life from him, and his life gave light to everyone. ⁵ The light keeps shining in the dark, and darkness has never put it out. John 1:3-5 (NCV)

Jesus answered, "What I teach is not my own. My teaching comes from the one who sent me. ¹⁷ People who really want to do what God wants will know that my teaching comes from God. They will know that this teaching is not my own. ¹⁸ If I taught my own ideas, I would just be trying to get honor for myself. But if I am trying to bring honor to the one who sent me, I can be trusted. Anyone doing that is not going to lie. John 7:16-18 (ERV)

3. The WORD is designed to *change me.* (v.9-13)

The true light was coming into the world. This is the true light that gives light to all people. ¹⁰ The Word was already in the world. The world was made through him, but the world did not know him. ¹¹ He came to the world that was his own. And his own people did not accept him. ¹² But some people did accept him. They believed in him, and he gave them the right to become children of God. ¹³ They became God's children, but not in the way babies are usually born. It was not because of any human desire or plan. They were born from God himself. John 1:9-13 (ERV)
