## **Forgiving From My Heart**

"Lord, <u>how many times</u> shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? <u>Up to seven times</u>?" <sup>22</sup> Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times." **Matthew 18:21-22 (NIV)** 

### Why should I forgive others?

### 1. Because God <u>forgives</u> me. (v.23-27)

"...the kingdom of heaven is like a king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. <sup>24</sup> As he began the settlement, a man who owed him ten thousand bags of gold was brought to him. <sup>25</sup> Since he was not able to pay, the master ordered that he and his wife and his children and all that he had be sold to repay the debt. <sup>26</sup> At this the servant fell on his knees before him. 'Be patient with me,' he begged, 'and I will pay back everything.' <sup>27</sup> The servant's master took pity on him, canceled the debt and let him go."

Matthew 18:23-27 (NIV)

Get along with each other, and forgive each other. If someone does wrong to you, forgive that person because the Lord forgave you.

Colossians 3:13 (NCV)

"...'I canceled all that debt of yours because you begged me to.

33 Shouldn't you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?"

Matthew 18:32-33 (NIV)

# 2. Because God will not forgive me if I'm unforgiving. (v.32-35)

"Then the master called the servant in. 'You wicked servant,' he said, 'I canceled all that debt of yours because you begged me to.

33 Shouldn't you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?' 34 In anger his master handed him over to the jailers to be tortured, until he should pay back all he owed. 35 This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister from your heart."

Matthew 18:32-35 (NIV)

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. <sup>15</sup> But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV)

## How do I develop a forgiving heart?

## 1. I appreciate God's forgiveness.

Forgive each other the same as God forgave you through Christ.

Ephesians 4:32 (ERV)

#### 2. I <u>resist</u> the urge to <u>get even</u>.

Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else.

1 Thessalonians 5:15 (NIV)

Dear friends, don't try to get even. Let God take revenge. In the Scriptures the Lord says, "I am the one to take revenge and pay them back."

Romans 12:19 (CEV)

# 3. I treat others with grace.

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. **Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)** 

# 4. I grieve when those who hurt me fall.

Do not gloat when your enemy falls; when they stumble, do not let your heart rejoice... **Proverbs 24:17 (NIV)** 

#### 5. I *pray* for those who hurt me.

"...Whenever you pray, forgive anything you have against anyone. Then your Father in heaven will forgive your failures."

Mark 11:25 (GW)

"...Ask God to bless the people who ask for bad things to happen to you. Pray for the people who are mean to you." Luke 6:28 (ERV)

#### 6. I seek reconciliation.

Do everything possible on your part to live in peace with everybody.

**Romans 12:18 (GNT)** 

### 7. I <u>serve</u> them in their <u>distress</u>.

"Whenever you come across your enemy's ox or donkey wandering loose, be sure to take it back to him." **Exodus 23:4 (GW)**
