Matt. 16:15-17

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" ¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." ¹⁷ And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. (NASB)

Q: What does it mean to be blessed?

It means you're in a good position!

Q: How can we be "Blessed" like Peter?

1. By being <u>hungry</u> and <u>thirsty</u> for righteousness.

Matt. 5:6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied."

Q: How do we know that Peter was hungry and thirsty for righteousness?

- (Matt. 10:2) Peter didn't blend in... he was hungry!
- (Matt. 14:28) Peter got out of the boat to be like Jesus!
- (Matt. 15:15) Peter wanted to know how to apply the Lord's teaching!

ASK YOURSELF...

What would "Hungry and thirsty for righteousness" look like in MY life?

Matt. 6:33

"But <u>seek first</u> His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." (NASB)

A. Finding out what pleases the Lord (<u>Eph. 5:10</u>) B. Doing what pleases the Lord (<u>James 1:25</u>) C. Giving to others more than getting (<u>Acts 20:35</u>) D. Good Marriage or Getting Married (<u>Gen. 2:18</u>) E. Earning Money (<u>1Tim. 5:8</u>) F. Kids (Psa. 127:4-5) G. House (Prov. 24:3-4) H. Recreation or Vacation (Ex. 23:12)

2. By being <u>pure</u> in <u>heart</u>.

Matt. 5:8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. (NASB)

• This isn't about being morally perfect or sexually pure; this is about loving God with your **whole heart**... not just part of it.

<u>Deut. 6:5</u> "You shall love the LORD your God <u>with all</u> your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. (NASB)

Isaiah 29:13-14 Then the Lord said, "Because this people draw near with their words and honor Me with their lip service, but they remove their hearts far from Me, and their reverence for Me consists of tradition learned by rote, ¹⁴ Therefore behold, I will once again deal marvelously with this people, wondrously marvelous; and the wisdom of their wise men will perish, and the discernment of their discerning men will be concealed."

(NASB)
