Why was THE message of the Kingdom 'Good News'?

- 1. God's <u>plan</u> is <u>happening!</u> Exodus 19:1-6 - Prophets - Jesus - Apostles - 1 Peter 2:9-10
- 2. It ain't what ya think It's BETTER!!!

What did Jesus tell us about the Kingdom?

1. <u>Citizenship</u> is <u>voluntary</u>.

- 3. <u>Citizenship</u> is <u>conditional</u>.
