The Power of the Resurrection is restoring **The reality of living in God's presence.** 

In the Beginning God created mankind to live in His presence.

"They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden."

Gen 3:8 (NASB)

"*Presence*" is the Hebrew word "**paniym**" (*paw-neem* ) which means "face."

• God created us to live Face to Face with Him.

"Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, **and live forever**"— <sup>23</sup> therefore the LORD God sent him out from the garden of Eden, to cultivate the ground from which he was taken. <sup>24</sup> So He drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden **He stationed the cherubim and the flaming sword which turned every direction to guard the way to the tree of life.**"

Gen. 3:23-24 (NASB)

 Mankind entered a new reality, separated from intimacy with God and the Tree of Life.

God couldn't let mankind stay in the garden, but He didn't abandon them.

• Ex 25:8 "Let them construct a sanctuary for Me, that I may dwell among them." (NASB)

God chose to have a dwelling place among men, but mankind could only enter His presence once a year... they couldn't live there. "You shall make a veil of blue and purple and scarlet material and fine twisted linen; **it shall be made with cherubim**, the work of a skillful workman... **the veil shall serve for you as a partition between the holy place and the holy of holies.**"

Ex. 26:31-33 (NASB)

• The Holy of Holies was perfectly square and separated by a veil embroidered with Cherubim... just like Eden.

"And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed His last. <sup>38</sup> And the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom." Mark 15:37-38 (NASB)

- Through Jesus, God has removed the barrier that separated us!
- What we have now is just a taste of what's coming... a deposit guaranteeing what is to come! (2Cor. 1:22; 5:1-5)

The last scene in the Bible (<u>Rev 21</u>) describes what it will be like when God restores the reality of living with Him.

## What does God want me to do?

"But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare. <sup>11</sup>Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives <sup>12</sup> as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming. That day will bring about the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt in the heat. <sup>13</sup> But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, where righteousness dwells." 2Pet. 3:10-13 (NIV)
